LEA Completeness Determination for SWFP Permit Application Package

Dear Mr. Hackett:

On March 16, 2023, the City of Los Angeles Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received an application package from Active Recycling Company for a modification of the solid waste facility permit for the Active Recycling Material Recovery and Transfer Facility (Active) large volume transfer/processing facility that is located in Los Angeles, CA. The application was for the replacement of metal to recyclable material in the permitted area within of the property. The LEA reviewed the application package according to the solid waste facility permit requirements found in Title 14 and Title 27 of the California Code of Regulations and on April 11, 2023, the LEA made the determination that the application package is complete and correct and is ready for filing.

This permit application package contains the following items:

- A completed application (CIWMB form E-1-77).
 The LEA has reviewed the application and has determined that the operator has properly completed the form. The application package contains a statement from Mrs. Marilyn D. Segal, Owner of Active Recycling certifying that the application is true and accurate to the best of his knowledge.
- 2. A complete and correct Transfer/Processing Report (TPR).

 The LEA has reviewed the Active Transfer/Processing Report and has determined that it complies with the requirements found in 14 CCR 18221.6.

3. California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) compliance.
The City of Los Angeles, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) had pren

The City of Los Angeles, Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) had prepared and circulated a draft Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND), State Clearinghouse Number 2013111058, for a revised solid waste facility permit on May 30, 2017. The LEA received an addendum to that MND on March 27, 2023 that would replace the recycled metal with curbside recyclables.

The environmental document as herein amended may be used to fulfill the environmental review requirements of the current MND and associated permit. The LEA made the determination that the project would not have a negative environmental impact on the area. Because the current project meets the conditions for the application of State CEQA Guidelines Section 15164, preparation of a new EIR or ND is not required. Discretionary processing of the modified permit may now proceed with the understanding that any substantial changes in the proposal may be subject to further environmental review.

4. Finding of Conformance.

The Active facility is listed in the City of Los Angeles Nondisposal Facility Element (NDFE).

As required by 27 CCR 21650, the LEA is submitting a copy of the accepted application form, a copy of the TPR, and a copy of the addendum as an attachment to this determination letter.
