### 3. AC Optimization [www.ladwp.com/acopt](http://www.ladwp.com/acopt)

The HVAC Optimization Program provides services by certified, professional heating, ventilation, and air conditioning (HVAC) technicians to analyze cooling systems and provide basic maintenance to maximize system efficiency. This service is offered to eligible residential and commercial LADWP customers at no cost. This program includes an option to install a programmable thermostat free of charge. (Single family, multi family, small commercial)

Heat Pump:

Single Family - \$3,000 per heat pump

Multifamily - \$2,000 per heat pump

### 4. Consumer Rebate Program [www.ladwp.com/crp](http://www.ladwp.com/crp)

The Consumer Rebate Program (CRP) is designed to both educate and influence purchasing decisions of LADWP residential customers by offering rebates for the purchase of qualifying energy-saving products that meet or exceed ENERGY STAR® efficiency ratings, Title 20, Title 24, and/or the Cool Roof Rating Council (CRRC) criteria. (Single family, Multifamily)

Central or Split AC 15 SEER \$100/Ton

Central or Split AC ≥16 SEER \$120/Ton

Central Heat Pump ≥8.5 HSPF, ≥15 SEER \$100/Ton \$100 - \$120 per ton

LADWP's Zero By Design encourages developers to build more sustainably by providing financial incentives for commercial and high-rise multifamily new construction projects which exceed Title 24 or industry standards. (commercial)

Receive Owner incentives to help offset the added costs of building more efficiently.

Design Teams may also be eligible for incentives by attaining aggressive energy savings goals.

In addition, applicants receive complimentary design assistance and review to aid them in realizing
