Transmittal of Registration Permit and 5-year Permit Review Report

Dear Mr. Gasparian,

On April 8, 2016, the City of Los Angeles Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received an application package from American Reclamation for a 5-year Permit Review and a new Registration Permit for the American Reclamation CDI Processing Facility located at 4560 Doran Street in Los Angeles, California. The LEA has reviewed the application package and has made the following findings:

1. The application package identifies American Reclamation as the facility operator and contains the contact person, address, and phone number. The application package identifies the Glendale Metals and Recycling, Inc., as the owner of the property and contains the appropriate contact information.
2. The application contains the correct section in Chapters 3 or 3.1 of Division 7 of this Title authorizing eligibility for this tier. The application package describes the facility's operations and how it will comply with applicable state regulations. The facility will have a maximum capacity of 175 tons per day of construction, demolition and inert debris with an annual loading of 63,875 tons. The facility will be open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.
3. The facility is listed in the City of Los Angeles Non-Disposal Facility Element (NDFE), approved May 25, 2010.
4. A copy of the application package was transmitted to the Director of the City Planning Department.
5. No public hearings were required for the permitting of this facility.

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
6. The application package contains a statement by the owner and operator certifying under penalty of perjury that the information which they have provided is true and accurate to the best of their knowledge and belief.

A 5-year Permit Review was conducted concurrently with the review of the Registration Permit application. For purposes of both, the LEA reviewed registration permit application, the facility plan, inspection reports, and weight & volume records. The LEA determined that the proposed changes requested in the registration permit application are appropriate for a medium volume CDI debris processing facility and will allow for American Reclamation to operate the facility in compliance with state minimum standards. A copy of the permit review report is included in this package.

In accordance with 14 CCR 18104.2, the LEA has made the following determination. The application package meets the requirements of 14 CCR 18104.1. Therefore, the LEA is issuing the enclosed Registration Permit to American Reclamation to operate a medium volume construction, demolition and inert debris processing facility. This letter shall serve as notification to CalRecycle of the issuance of the Registration Permit.
