Dear Mr. Gasparian,

On September 12, 2024, the City of Los Angeles Local Enforcement Agency (LEA) received an application package from American Reclamation for a new Registration Permit for a medium volume construction and demolition/inert (CDI) debris processing facility located at 4560 Doran Street in Los Angeles, California. The LEA has reviewed the application package and has made the following findings:


1. The application contains the name and address of the City of Los Angeles LEA and correctly identifies the section authorizing eligibility for the issuance of a temporary registration permits for pre-existing large volume CDI processing facility.
2. The application contains a facility plan that complies with the requirements of 14 CCR 18223 and describes the facility's operations and how it will comply with applicable state regulations.
3. The application contains the required information regarding the facility operator and land owner and the addresses at which legal process may be served.
4. American Reclamation is identified in the City of Los Angeles Non-Disposal Facility Element (NDFE) and a copy of the applicable section is included in the facility plan.

5. The application package contains a statement by the owner and operator certifying under penalty of perjury that the information, which they have provided, is true and accurate to the best of their knowledge and belief.

In accordance with 14 CCR 18104.2, the LEA has made the determination that the application package meets the requirements of 14 CCR 18104.1. Therefore, the LEA is issuing the enclosed Registration Permit to American Reclamation, Inc. to operate a medium volume CDI facility. This letter shall serve as notification to CalRecycle of the issuance of the Registration Permit.
